Party MAG-Net is an established health promotion and harm reduction project in the luxembourgish party scene. In April 2014, we launched a new service named DUCK, providing recreational drug users with the opportunity to analyse their products.

DUCK is a joint project of the National Addiction Prevention Centre (CePT), the National Health Laboratory (LNS), with the support of the Ministry of Health and the General Prosecutor's Office.




